

Have you heard people using terms like the cloud, cloud computing, or cloud storage.


And you're clueless or really don't understand about the cloud.

Cloud Confusion

One in five Americans (22 percent) admit that they've **pretended to know what the cloud is** or how it works.



When asked what "the cloud" is, a majority responded it's either an actual cloud (specifically a "fluffy white thing"), the sky or something related to the weather (29 percent). 51% said stormy weather would interfere with their cloud computing





- It is storing and accessing data and programs over the Internet instead of your computer's hard drive

What is the Cloud?

- The "cloud" is just a symbol for the internet.
- The term "cloud computing" has been around since 1977 when a cloud was used to represent a connection to the Internet outside computers
- You know it's there, you just can't see inside it much like a real cloud in the sky.



Why Use the Cloud

- It's convenient
- It's reliable
- We can access our data from any device with an Internet connection
- Can share photos, documents, etc.
- Effective backup solution



Cloud Computing

Having secure access to all your applications and data from any network device


Where Does Everything Live?

What is a Server aka Data Center?

- At its most basic level, "the cloud" is just fancy talk for a network of connected servers.
- A server is simply a computer that provides data or services to our devices (computers, tablets, phones, etc.) over the Internet.
- Server farms provide massive storage and processing power

 - Any place in the world



- Files stored on cloud servers are encrypted (scrambled), which makes it harder for cybercriminals to access.

- Log in automatically
- Encrypted password database
- One master password to remember
- Can generate random passwords



Two-Factor Authorization (2FA)

- Two-step security authorization process
- In addition to password / passphrase
 - •Password & pin #
 - Fingerprint
 - Facial recognition (built-in camera)
 - •Text message
 - Phone call




iCloud


